Administrative history	<p>The Minnedosa Lake Rehabilitation Committee formed in 1988 around the time that it was announced that Minnedosa would be involved with the 1992 Manitoba Summer Games. The committees executive consisted of Chairman – Gerald Sparrow, Vice Chairman – Ken Harris, Secretary – Kelly Harvey. Projects included major renovations to the Pavilion, beach modifications, construction of a look out tower, lighting and flags along the dam, and children’s play structures. Sponsors and grants contributing to the projects included Special Conservation Fund, Funding Department of Natural Resources, Community Places Program, Minnedosa Parks and Recreation Board, Town of Minnedosa, Kinsmen Club, Lions Club and others. These projects were brought to successful completion by November 1992. One additional project was completed in 2003 which consisted of upgrading the public washroom.</p>
Scope & content	<p>The fonds consists of correspondences, financial records, grant submissions, minutes and 2 blue prints for the 2003 washroom upgrade. Few minutes are available. Most of the records consist of correspondences for researching projects and communicating progress to funding sources and the related government departments which were involved. Records are arranged in series as follows: 1) Correspondences, 2) Financial records, 3) Preliminary plans, 4) Minutes with plans for Beach area and Look Out Tower.</p>
Custodial history	<p>The fonds was last held by Robert Mummery at the Minnedosa Tribune. Robert Mummery then deposited the fonds at the Minnedosa Regional Archives in 2006.</p>
