Administrative history	<p>As early 1925 CPR employees organized their own orchestra and tennis courts. A railroaders day in conjunction with Minnedosa's annual summer festival was organized early on. In 1970 the railroaders committee participated in Manitoba's centennial celebrations with a major achievement of establishing Tanner's Park in Minnedosa. Founding Officers were Ken Harris, chairman; Ida Bracken, secretary; Archie Coates, treasurer; along with Glen Everett, Eric Potts, John Johnson, Bernice Stone, John Carrick, Bill Hooper and Ted Gowing. Administrative history retrieved from the Minnedosa's 100th Anniversary history book. Other administrative history is unavailable.</p>
