Biographical sketch	Alexander and Jane Brown Abel in 1878 settled at SW 28/15/18 close to where the Cameron church is located. In 1889 they purchased W ½ 32/15/18. It is this half section that was designated a century farm in 2012 by their descendants, Murray and Brenda Burton Abel. Alexander and Jane raised a family of eleven children. Alexander passed in 1920 followed by Jane in 1951 and both are buried in the Fairmount Cemetery.
